Local company raises Saima roof

NorthStar Construction Services Corp. recently donated time and labor to help put a new roof on the almost 100-year-old building of the Finnish Center at Saima Park.

Through the Firestone Community Service Program, the roofing contractor donated time and \$2,000 worth of Firestone roofing materials to help with the overall project.

The Finnish Center at Saima Park is a non-profit organization dedicated to preserving the Finland culture and integrating it into U.S. culture.

"We are extremely grateful that NorthStar introduced us to Firestone's Community Service Program and are thankful for both companies' generosity," said Maija Mard, president of the Finnish Center

at Saima Park. "We wouldn't have been able to complete this project without their help."

The roofing project involved the removal of the old 1,100-square-foot BUR system that covered the flat portion of the roof and suffered from multiple leaks. The crew then installed a Firestone RubberGard EPDM roofing system with one-inch Firestone ISO 95+ polyiso insulation and Firestone metal around the edges. A roofing crew of six NorthStar Construction employees completed the project.
